Chief Claims M.R.A. Is Answer To Mau-Mau

Caux sur Montreux, Sunday.

"An idea to replace Mau Mau in Africa and Communism in the world." was how a Kenya chief, Jonathan Barbas, described moral rearmament to the world assembly meeting in Caux sur Montreux recently.

"Something akin to Mau Mau started in my district," he said. "Many people were imprisoned but that did not stop it. We applied an idea better than Mau Mau—M.R.A."

Chief Barasa, who was awarded a badge of merit in the Coronation honours, said: "Today my people have received honours for our maize and coffee, and are leading in community enterprises in Kenya. People are looking for an answer. If they don't get the right one, they take the wrong one, whether it is Mau Mau or Communism."

"Our country needs to replace Mau Mau with M.R.A. We need to replace Communism with moral rearmament and the world will be rebuilt."
