

# MR. MOHLALA AT CAUX

"One of the biggest causes of racial unrest in South Africa was the shortage of housing for the African population," said Mr. J. M. Mohlala Chairman of the Springs Advisory Board. He was addressing the Moral Re-Armament World Assembly at Caux, Switzerland. He described how in Springs, where homes had been needed for 21,000 African families, they had begun to find a solution to the problem through the initiative of the town engineer and the co-operation and foresight of the Town Council.

"I believe it is one of the first times in South Africa that African artisans have been used on such a project," he continued. Four-roomed houses in quarter-acre lots with full plumbing and a monthly rent of £2 10s. were produced at a rate of 8 houses a day.
