They hope to bring sanity to White S.A.

PROMINENT African leaders and businessmen yesterday announced a countrywide campaign to "bring White South Africa back to sanity."

The campaign has been organised by Mr. P. Q. Vundia, an executive of Moral Rearmament. Its leaders hope to make personal contact with influential Whites, including top industrialists, businessmen and cabinet ministers.

They will ask Nationalists on the platteland to organise meetings so that campaign leaders may address "Whites who have never had an opportunity of meeting Africans" to hear the African point of view.

PERSONAL TOUCH

Mr. Vundla explained his idea yesterday. "There will be no politics in this movement," he said. "The basic idea is to get to know each other — to show Whites that Africans are human beings with fears, hopes, aspirations and feeling.

"We will endeavour to bring 'White South Africa back to sanity.' This cannot be done from a distance and only personal contact can achieve anything now."

Mr. Vundla hopes his idea will eventually lead to an official round table conference between the Government and responsible African leaders.

He is attempting to arrange private meetings with Dr. Verwoerd, Mr. De Wet Nel and Mr. Fouche.
