White Man Tells Non-Europeans "I Was Wrong"

CAPE TOWN, Monday.—About 400 people—Europeans, Coloureds, Natives and Indians—attended a moral re-armament meeting at the University of Cape Town during the Easter week-end.

A Native student told them: "I used to hate anything about the white man. But I have changed."

APOLOGISE

From the same platform a Stellenbosch University lecturer said he had grown up with the idea that a white man was better than a non-European.

"But now I have heard of the pain that this attitude causes. To all non-Europeans I want to apologise for my unthinking heartlessness."

Among those at the conference were representatives of the African Teachers' Federation, the African National Congress Youth League, the National Council of African Women, the Coloured Peoples' National Union, the Diplomatic Corps, Parliament and industry.—SAPA.
