

# BLACKS 'HAVE BEEN TOO APOLOGETIC' ABOUT COLOUR

THE president of the Transkei Women's Christian Association said yesterday Blacks in South Africa "have been too apologetic about their colour."

Mrs Bobantu Adina Ndamse said South African Blacks "are beginning to discover themselves and Black consciousness."

We have been too apologetic about our own beliefs and apologetic about our colour. We have been too apologetic about our own religion. We have been too apologetic about our own being, and now as Blacks in South Africa we want to rediscover ourselves, and it is the White man that can help us.

"Not paternalistically, but as

equals, as human beings, and it is in this that I see moral re-armament as the hope for South Africa."

Mrs Ndamse was speaking at the opening of the Moral Re-armament Association's world assembly in Caux, above Lake Geneva.
