# Smith's son walks in

LONDON — The British Foreign Office may have banned paraplegic Rhodesians from taking part in sport in the UK, but they did not stop Mr Alec Smith, son of the Rhodesian premier, from attending the Moral Rearmament conference in London this week, writes the Daily Express gossip columnist today.

Mr Smith (28) said: "I have a British passport and just walked in through immigration in the normal way. Smith is a very common name — no-one knew who I was."

The Foreign Office, says the columnist, claim their "stop list" applies only to members of the Rhodesian Front and Rhodesians without British passports.
