"SPRINGBOK Stampede" is at present visiting Pietermaritzburg. This group of young people will be appearing in the City Hall this evening and are well worth going to see and hear. They have been visiting various centres of South Africa and their dynamic performances have enthralled audiences wherever they have been.

Many of the young people who belong to "Springbok Stampede" have already left school but there are at present 20 members of the cast who are studying for their matric. These young people, although travelling around the countryside, still must and do find time to do their normal school work. This they manage to do more than adequately. Last year three pupils of the travelling school obtained first class matric passes.

Their work is done through various correspondence courses offered by different colleges. Where students are teachers come up against a problem, they receive help from teachers in the towns which they visit. Practical work is done at various schools as well, these schools offer the travelling school their facilities for the various subjects, and the pupils then do the work before travelling to their next venue.

The members of "Springbok Stampede" who have completed their schooling have their time occupied by various tasks, while the others are attending to their school work.

No one is paid for the work which they do and everybody has some task to perform.
