Cathedral call: the Reverend George Daneel, a Pretoria man who happens to be the longest surviving Springbok rugby player, has been invited to deliver a sermon in Nairobi's All Saints Cathedral. Mr Daneel (86), a retired minister of the Ned Geref Kerk, has been invited to an All Africa Conference being held in the Kenyan capital from tomorrow to May 27. Delegates from Africa, Latin America, Asia and Europe will discuss the problems facing Africa. Mr Daneel, a Western Province forward, played eight tests in the green and gold between 1928 and 1932.
