

Brian Boobbyer Gives Up Rugby

LONDON, Monday.—Brian Boobbyer, the international Rugby football star, has given up sport to become a moral rearmament worker in the Far East.

The 24-year-old Oxford University player stayed behind in Tokyo when the University Rugby team ended their Japanese tour.

The Moral Rearmament Movement, formerly known as the Oxford Group, was founded 30 years ago at Oxford by Dr. Frank Buchman, a 73-year-old American and a former Cambridge student.—SAPA.—Reuter.
