

# Nat paper concern for Africans

**NEGLECTING** the problem of how to treat urban Africans will create breeding places for trouble in White areas, says the Nationalist Sunday newspaper, Rapport.

In a leading article in yesterday's issue, the paper, referring to an interview with the newly appointed president of the Institute of Race Relations, Dr. William Nkomo said: "It is good to hear a Black leader speak so peacefully about the problems of his people.

"Tranquillity is a property which we can well exhibit to a greater extent in discussing the problems of our relationships. Whites and Non-Whites are prone to let their emotions speak in such cases instead of sound sense.

"Dr. Nkomo's great worry is apparently the urban Africans. And perhaps we should take another look at the problems which he says these people are experiencing.

"We have made good progress with our policy of Bantu homelands. Concerning Africans in the cities, we have not
