# **"We fight Leftists, beatniks" —M.R.A.**

**MORAL RE-ARMAMENT** aimed at "grabbing the mike" from Leftists and beatniks and sounding a clear call for love of home, homeland and humanity, Mr. J. N. Ferreira, director of his organisation's musical show, "Springbok Stormloop," said in Pretoria yesterday.

He was commenting on a scathing attack made on the Stormloop show by the Nederduitse Gereformeerde Kerk in the "Onderwysblad" teachers' journal.

In the attack (the Rev. J. H. Jooste said that a choice between Moral Re-Armament and Communism meant a choice between two forms of the same evil—internationalism.

Mr. Ferreira, commenting, said that the musical show was part of the aim of ensuring that South Africa shared responsibility for the continent's development.

"We believe in the dignity and talents of every tribe and race in Africa, and that together we can end violence, dictatorship and Communism.

"We aim to give youth a purpose and to create incorruptible leadership for the future. We aim to create united homes, and we aim to offer industry a common purpose for labour and management," he said.
