# LET S.A. ALONE —PLEA

**DURBAN.** — The former famous West Indies cricketer, Mr Conrad Hunte, who is also an influential member of Moral Rearmament, said in Pietermaritzburg today that South Africa should be left alone to sort out its own complex problems.

The Republic should be able to move towards change in its racial situation without pressure or interference from the outside world, he said.

Mr Hunte, who is on a private visit and who last week attended the wedding of a fellow Moral Rearmament member in Durban, said he was pleased with the multi-racial moves in sport.

He was confident that greater changes would come about but repeatedly stressed in an interview that the country should be allowed to make these changes at its own pace and not be pressurised into hasty decisions.
