# “Maties” meet African leaders

Four Stellenbosch University students have returned from a visit overseas as guests of some Scandinavian students who organized boycotts against South Africa in 1960/61.

Jan Horn, Johannes Jurgens, Johan Greeff and Emil Weder spent several weeks travelling with the Scandinavian students through Southern Germany.

Mr. Horn, in Johannesburg on the way back, to the Cape, said the Scandinavians had been glad to get Stellenbosch students as their guests.

“They know that five of our six Prime Ministers were educated at Stellenbosch and that it is the heart of Afrikaner intellectualism. And they wanted students with a strong Afrikaner - nationalistic background.”

The four also attended a Moral Rearmament conference in London on December 28.

In London the four men had discussions with many African leaders, including diplomats from Nigeria, Ghana, Mali and Uganda.

Mr. Horn said that African leaders were frustrated by the complete lack of contact with South Africa.

One African politician told him: “We do not want bloodshed in Africa or South Africa. We do not really want you expelled from the United Nations. But South Africa has shut itself off from the rest of Africa and is only concerned with its own welfare and progress.”

## IMPRESSED

Mr. Horn said that he and his fellow students had been tremendously impressed by their discussions overseas and they had decided:

- We are going to try to live honest and incorruptible lives and that is what we demand of our Government—to be honest to themselves and honest to God.

- We say that traditions and cultures of all races in our country should be restored and upheld.

- The accent should be put on character and a man judged on merit and not on his colour.

- We want a church and a nation governed by God and not by man.

- The doors of our country must be opened to outside students. In this way we will reap the intellectual cream of Africa.

- The profits of our industries must be used to help underdeveloped parts of Africa.
