Press chief's call for M.R.A.

CAUX (Switzerland), Monday.—
Mr. James Coltart, managing director of the Thomson newspaper chain in Britain, told the Moral Re-armament Easter conference here. "We must outbid Russia's economic bid for Africa.

"It is our responsibility to provide for the needs of Africa—and to usher in the renaissance of Moral Rearmament," he added.

Mr. Coltart pledged himself to "re-orientate the thinking of Great Britain and to root out evil ruthlessly in every quarter."

He was determined to reach every member of the Cabinet, every trade unionist, the directors of television, radio and Press in Britain, he said.

Moral Re-armament, he said, provided the answer to Mr. Khrushchev's present "educational offensive" by creating "an incorruptible leadership for a new era in history."—Sapa-Reuter.
