'SA dogged by fear'

LONDON — South Africa is dogged by bitterness on the part of the Blacks and fear on the side of the Whites, a Black lecturer from the University of South Africa, has said here.

Mr Cornelius Marivate told a Moral Rearmament

conference in Switzerland, "when bitter men confront frightened men, the frightened men easily pull the trigger and catastrophe happens."

He said that if the Government had apologised after the Soweto shootings, instead of trying to justify the police

actions, there would be less bitterness on the part of the Blacks.

The Rev George Daneel, a minister in the Dutch Reformed Church and former Springbok rugby player, said that the Whites had caused much of the division which led to the riots by "our arrogance,
