Springbok Stampede back again

The cast of "Springbok Stampede" which has recently completed a tour of South Africa, will present shows in the Krugersdorp Town Hall on February 6 and 7.

This group, which is part of the moral re-armament movement, is made up of 40 students of university and high school level, who have temporarily sacrificed their careers to work with Springbok Stampede.

The students study by correspondence under the guidance of trained teachers who have also given up their jobs to work with the movement.
